Dear guest,

The Dasindo community gives you a warm welcome in its mountain home and wishes you a pleasant stay.

We think it is important to provide you with some information so you can understand who we are and how our organisation works (we are available for any further information you may need).

The village of Dasindo, in the municipality of Comano Terme, in application of a commission decree of the last century, owns woods (about 360 ha) and agricultural land (about 30 ha) of which the 120 residents are owners.

The allocation of the above-mentioned lands to the residents of Dasindo was intended to ensure that they could satisfy their most urgent living needs (firewood, construction timber, meadows for grazing livestock, agricultural land for cultivation...).

Today's different living conditions mean that these needs have been partially overcome, while introducing a different way of using available resources to promote the well-being of the population.

Particularly important is the protection of our beautiful environment, which we want to enhance and share with our guests.

The house we provide was built from an old ruin using only the resources gained from collective property management and the voluntary work of the inhabitants of Dasindo, who can now use it free of charge.

We hope you make the best use of the house and all the surrounding area, which offers interesting spots that you can visit:

- Farmer's cooperative of Val Giudicarie (with shop of typical local products)
- Organic farm of Andrea Mattei
- Donkey breeding of Moira Donati
- Fish farming "Fonti del Dal"
- Cultivation of apples, cherries and small fruits
- Livestock farms (with cage-free hens breeding and eggs sales)
- Honey producers
